Michigan Gaming Control Board Pari-Mutuel Rules

All Pari-Mutuels are run under the rules made and published by the **Michigan Gaming Control Board**, and according to these rules, all persons buying tickets thereon agree to be bound by said rules and decisions of the Stewards. All payoffs by the pari-mutuel departments of the licenses by the racing commissioner are subject to the regulations of the United States Government, the Internal Revenue Service, and applicable statutes of the State of Michigan."

R 431.201

- (a) "Betting Interest" means a single horse, or more than 1 horse joined as a mutuel entry or joined in the mutuel field, on which a single wager may be placed.
- (b) "Entry" means either of the following:
 - (1) A horse entered in a race.
 - (2) Two or more horses which are entered in a race and which are coupled as a mutuel entry or joined in the mutuel field pursuant to rules of the Gaming Control Board.
- (c) "Mutuel Entry" means 2 or more horses entered in a race which are coupled as a single betting interest because the horses are owned wholly or in part by the same owners or are trained by the same trainer.
- (d) "Mutuel Field" means a single betting interest which involves more than 1 horse and which is formed, when the number of horses starting in a race exceeds the number capacity of the totalisator by grouping the highest numbered horse within the numbering capacity of the totalisator and all horses of a higher number.

R 431.2005

- (a) "Place", when used in the context of a single position in the order of finish in a race, means second. When used in the context of pari-mutuel wagering, a "place" wager is one involving a payoff on a betting interest which finished first or second in a race. When used in the context of multiple positions in the order of finish in a race, "place" or "placing" means finishing first, second, or third.
- (b) "Post Time" means the time set for arrival of the horses in a race at the starting post.
- (c) "Scratch" means the withdrawal of a horse entered for a race after the time of closing.
- (d) "Starter" means a horse in front of whom the stall doors of the starting gate open at the time the starter dispatches the field, or when no starting gate is used or a mobile starting gate is used, the starter gives the word "go".
- (e) "Winner" means a horse whose nose reaches the wire first carrying its jockey or driver, a horse whose nose reaches the wire at the same instant as the nose of a horse sharing first place carrying its jockey or driver, or a horse awarded first place by the Michigan Gaming Control Board or stewards because of the disqualification of an actual first-place finisher.

R 431.2010 Pari-Mutuel ticket sales payoffs

- (a) Pari-mutuel tickets shall be sold only at either regular ticket windows which are properly designated by signs or through authorized systems or messengers. Pari-mutuel tickets shall not be exchanged, except as otherwise provided for in R431.2105, R431.2110, and R 431.2115.
- (b) Wagers shall be paid when a race is declared official by the stewards. A race shall be deemed official when an official sign is purposely displayed or an official announcement is made. Any subsequent ruling of the commissioner or stewards with regard to the award of purse money shall have no bearing on the mutual payoff.
- (c) Payment on winning pari-mutuel tickets shall be made only upon presentation and surrender of such tickets.
- (d) All winning pari-mutuel tickets may be presented for payment to the association concerned within 60 days after the last day of the race meeting pursuant to section 2 of Act No. 90 of the Public Acts of 1951, as amended, being S431.252 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- (e) Tickets altered or mutilated in any way are void and worthless. Torn tickets, if properly identifiable, will be honored by the association. The responsibility for identifying tickets rests with the association.
- (f) A winning ticket shall not pay less than \$1.10 on a wager of \$1.00, and the minimum value of winning tickets of a higher denomination shall be in direct proportion thereto. A licensee shall not use any part of the state tax or the state's share of the breakage to make up any minus pool.
- (g) If there is any error in calculation where the public is underpaid, the amount of the underpayment shall be added to the same pool on the next race. If such an error results in the public being overpaid, the amount of the overpayment is chargeable against the funds of the racing association.
- (h) Payments will be made only on the first 3 horses passing the finish line according to the official order of finish, except in the case of a dead heat for show, in which case payments will be made on the first four horses.
- (i) If a horse is excused from racing for any reason after the betting thereon has begun, or if a horse becomes locked in the starting gate, the money bet on that horse shall be refunded, except that when the horse is part of an entry or a mutuel field, there shall be no refund if the entry or the mutuel field, as the case may be, has at least 1 actual starter.
- (j) The association shall require positive identification of a winning ticket holder before payment when, in the steward's discretion, circumstances warrant the action.

R 431.2015 Emergencies; Errors

- (a) If any emergency arises in connection with the operation of the mutuel department and the emergency is not covered by these rules and an immediate decision is necessary, the mutuel manager shall make the decision, and a prompt record of the facts shall be made to the stewards and the Gaming Control Board.
- (b) If an error is made in posting the odds or payoff figures to the public board, it shall be corrected promptly and only the correct amounts shall be used in the payoff, irrespective of the error that may have appeared on the public board. If, because of mechanical failure, it is impossible to promptly correct the posted payoff, a statement shall be made over the public address system stating the facts and corrections.

R 431.2030 Machine Locking

- (a) The pari-mutuel machines shall be locked by a steward immediately upon the start of a race through an electrical control in the steward's stand or before the start of a race through a method subject to the approval of the Gaming Control Board.
- (b) If the start of the race is delayed beyond the official post time, as shown on the results board, without adequate reason or explanation, the stewards may, at their discretion, lock the pari-mutuel machines.
- (c) An association shall not be responsible for ticket sales which are not completed before the machines are locked.

Please be advised that S.B. 1314 was signed by Governor Engler on Thursday January 7, 1999. The bill was filed with the Secretary of State on Friday January 9, 1999, as Public Act 505 of 1998 and took immediate effect upon the signing and filing. Therefore, effective January 9, 1999 the following is in effect: Beginning in calendar year 1998 and each year thereafter, all the funds by a race meet licensee for the payment of outstanding uncashed winning tickets which have not been claimed by the owner within 60 days after the close of the race meeting would be retained by the licensee.

Michigan Gaming Control Board Breaking and Recall Rules

Recall: The starter may sound a recall only for the following reasons:

- (1) A horse scores ahead of the starting gate.
- (2) There is interference before the word "go" is given.
- (3) A horse has broken equipment which the starter notices.
- (4) A horse falls before the word "go" is given
- (5) A horse refuses to turn or come to the gate.

There will be no recall for breaking horses.

Breaking: When any horse breaks from their gate, their drivers shall at once, where clearance exists, take such horse to the outside and pull it to its gait. The following shall be considered violations of the Breaking Rule:

- (1) Failure to properly attempt to pull the horse to its gait.
- (2) Failure to take the outside where clearance exists.
- (3) Failure to lose ground while on a break.
- (4) Failure to have a horse on gait at the finish wire.

Notice:

- 1) Flash photography is not permitted at Northville Downs
- 2) Children must be accompanied by an adult to enter Northville Downs
- 3) Outside food and beverage is not permitted
- 4) Use of profanity is not permitted
- 5) Collecting discarded mutuel tickets is strictly prohibited
- 6) Northville Downs is a smoke free facility

The Big Horse Handicapper's Guide to Playing the Races

TYPES OF WAGERS

WIN

Pick one horse to win the race. You collect the WIN price for your horse.
Minimum Wager: \$2.00 Total Cost: \$2.00

PLACE

Pick one horse to finish first or second. You collect the PLACE price for your horse.
Minimum Wager: \$2.00 Total Cost: \$2.00

SHOW

Pick one horse to finish first, second, or third. You collect the SHOW price for your horse.
Minimum Wager: \$2.00 Total Cost: \$2.00

ACROSS THE BOARD

Pick one horse to finish first, second, or third. If your horse wins, you collect the WIN, PLACE, and SHOW prices for your horse. If your horse comes in second, you collect the PLACE, and SHOW prices for your horse. If your horse comes in third, you collect the SHOW price for your horse.
Minimum Wager: \$2.00 Total Cost: \$6.00

EXACTA

Pick the first two horses in the EXACT order of finish. Example: You choose #7 and #3. If #7 gets first place and #3 finishes in second place, you win!
Minimum Wager: \$2.00 Total Cost: \$2.00

EXACTA BOX

Pick at least two horses to finish the race in ANY order. Example: You play the #7 and #3 horses. If both horses finish first or second place, you win!
Minimum Wager: \$1 using two horses Total Cost: \$2.

TRIFECTA

Pick the first three horses in the EXACT order of finish. Example: You choose #7, #3 and #2. If the #7 wins, the #3 comes second and the #2 comes third, you win!
Minimum Wager: \$0.50 Total Cost: \$0.50

TRIFECTA BOX

Pick at least three horses to finish the race in ANY order. Example: You play the #7, #3, and #2 horses. If all three horses finish first, second and third in any order, you win!
Minimum Wager: \$0.50 using three horses Total Cost: \$3.00

SUPERFECTA

Pick the first four finishers in the EXACT order of finish.
Minimum Wager: \$0.10 Total Cost: \$0.10

SUPERFECTA BOX

Pick the first four finishers in ANY order of finish. Example: You play the #7, #3, #2, and #1 horses. If all four horses finish first, second, third, and fourth place in any order, you win!
Total Cost: \$2.40

DAILY DOUBLE

Pick the winner of two designated consecutive races.
Minimum Wager: \$2.00 Total Cost: \$2.00

PICK 3

Pick the winner of three designated consecutive races.
Minimum Wager: \$1.00 Total Cost: \$1.00

PICK 4

Pick the winner of four designated consecutive races.
Minimum Wager: \$1.00 Total Cost: \$1.00

WHAT TO SAY AT THE WINDOW

When Wagering, please remember to state:

1. **Track Name**
2. **Number** of the Race
3. **Amount** of the wager
4. **Type** of the wager
5. **Program Numbers** of your selections

1 The Post Position

Post positions are usually drawn randomly, and horses starting from the inside posts simply have less distance to travel. Pay attention to horses in posts 1 through 5, and pay special attention to the horses with inside post positions who had been in higher post positions in their last few starts; they may be due for an improved performance.

2 The Driver

Drivers, like other athletes, possess varying amounts of ability. The top drivers are easy to spot by looking at the stats next to their name (Total Races-Wins-Seconds-Thirds-Universal Driver Rating System, which is a driver's "batting average"). The drivers with the highest UDR know how to best plan out a race, and know how and when to get their horse to give his all.

3 Class

In order to keep the races competitive, horses are divided into stakes, conditioned and claiming races. A horse moving up in class will be facing tougher competition. A horse moving down in class may find this crowd a bit easier to beat. The simplest way to determine class—at the same racetrack—is to look at the purse amount for each race.

4 The Trainer

While the driver handles the horse in the race, the trainer is responsible for the horse's care the rest of the time. Trainers have statistics just like drivers, so look for the highest Universal Trainer Rating, or UTR, to find the most successful at that track.

5 Time

Almost all harness races are one mile in length, so looking at the last few times that the horse posted is an important factor. They are listed in fifths of a second, so 1:54:3 above means a mile time of 1 minute, 54 seconds and 3 fifths of a second. Some handicappers also pick a horse based on its final quarter-mile time.

6 Performance

Good horses are able to perform well week after week. In the upper right-hand portion of each horse's past performances is the track where he won his fastest mile of the year and the size of the track on which he raced. Also listed is the time of the fastest winning mile of the year, number of starts, wins, seconds, thirds, and money won for this year and last.

Race 2 F&M NW \$20,000 in 2023 Pace

6 - SANNA CRUZAA raced respectably in her return to Cloer's barn, stalking and staying on for third in the F&M Open on Opening Night. It's been four weeks since then, but nobody else in the field's raced since that night, either. **2 - LUCKY TOWN** earned minor checks in five of her last six between here and Northfield, and primarily against \$5k-7k claimers. Draw keeps her handy; staying power is ample for this group. **8 - LADY ANASTASIA** pressed hard and held second at 14-1 last out after making serious ground through the middle half. That grinding ability will serve her well here, and the staying power she showed against tougher in Cleveland two back was the turnaround for better form for this girl.

Race 8 F&M NW \$3,000 Last 4 Starts, Opt. Clm. \$7,500 Pace

4 - DELIGHTFUL SUMMER rode the pocket to an Open win in her return to Northville, and did well for minors in top-level races locally last fall, too. That consistent form paired with this kinder group makes for a very tough contender. **6 - ALLABOUTTHEMATERIAL** did the lion's share of the lifting in that Jan. 5 Open after toiling in high-level claimers and starter allowances at Northfield through December. All things equal, she's probably the better mare, but she'll have to work harder from this spot, too. **1 - SKYWAY ROCKATOP** won from an earned pocket in Cleveland a couple weeks ago, and now draws inside on a lateral move. Capable presser-stalker has found renewed staying power in recent weeks.

Race 10 Open Trot

4 - TRAVLIN SWAN was uninvolved at Northfield on Jan. 21, but almost lasted at odds-on in a local Open on Jan. 5. He hit the board in half his 2023 starts, largely against top-level fields in the Great Lakes region. **3 - MYSTICAL LANE** was out every step of his Jan. 5 mile behind Rose Run Vincent (who won narrowly from the pocket) and held third after pushing hard into a share of second up the backstretch. Credit the amount of work this guy did. Significant post relief should leave him lots fresher late in the mile. **2 - ROSE RUN VINCENT**, as mentioned above, won the Jan. 5 Open, but only just prevailed after getting a pocket ride. He does show consistent ability in top fields and he's drawn perfectly for another handy journey, but that could all contribute to a short price. Weigh value accordingly.

Race 11 F&M NW \$3,000 Last 4 Starts, Opt. Clm. \$7,500 Pace

5 - AVALON FREEZE stayed on well for minors in conditioned \$30k races at Northfield through the break. I'm inclined to forgive that last line altogether; this group is much kinder and the pace scenario is likely tons more manageable. **2 - FURIOSA** hit the exactor (she was in Ontario, so, yes, "exactor") in her last five races, all against similar claiming company and from all sorts of trips. London invader should be close and clear with ease from this spot. **7 - SKYWAY VENUS** climbed over horses late for third in her last after a wire-to-wire score here one level below. Versatility and form unite; outside draw is her biggest obstacle.
